Classes of Membership

- 1. Regular Membership. A Regular member is a person approved by the Board who is 18 years of age or older. They may participate in all activities of the Society. They shall pay annual dues and shall have voting rights. Spouse and dependents of Regular members may participate in all social activities of the Society however they shall not pay annual dues and shall not have voting rights.
- **2. Junior Membership.** A Junior member is a person approved by the Board who is between the ages of 14 and 18. They may participate in all activities of the Society. They shall pay half the annual dues of a regular member but shall not have voting rights.
- **3. Social Membership.** A Social member is a person only interested in the social activities of the Society. They may participate in all social activities. They shall pay half of the annual dues of a regular member but shall not have voting rights.

Membership Dues

- 1. Amount of membership dues. The annual membership fee for each category of membership shall be determined from time to time by resolution of voting members in good standing and shall be payable on or before the first day of each year.
- 2. Dues for 2025: Regular Member \$50. Junior member \$25. Social Member \$25.
